Achillea (yarrow) sun / well drained soil

Achillea 'Angel's Breath' 2' Double white flower from summer to early fall. Irresistible to butterflies. O

Achillea 'Debutante' 24-30" Ivory white flowers in summer O

Achillea 'Richard Nelson' 2' Silvery buds opening to wine pink, maturing to pale blush O

Achillea 'Schwellenberg' 2' Silver ferny foliage. Gold flowers, upright, vigorous, showy. T

Achillea 'Walter Funcke' 14" Compact silver, ferny upright foliage. Attractive copper, red & yellow plate-like flowers. Tolerant of drought, wind and heat. T

Achillea misc. 2-3' Gray feathery, wooly foliage with large flat heads of bright yellow flowers that dry well, showy P

Agastache (anise hyssop) sun

Agastache 'Golden Jubilee' 18-24" Blue flowers over chartreuse-yellow foliage F

Alchemilla (lady's mantle) sun/part shade

Alchemilla vulgaris 12-18" Great for edging, sprays of chartreuse flowers in July, splendid fan shaped leaves that collect dew drops as sparkling jewels, good cut flowers. F, P

Allium (ornamental onion) sun / well drained soil

Allium hollandicum 'Purple Sensation' 2' Large purple sphere blossoms on 3' stems, summer dormant, let self seed after 1st year. T

Allium senescens glaucum 12" Abundant lilac/lavender florets appear early spring in 3/4" globular clusters on 20" stems mid-summer. Drought tolerant. T

Allium schoenoprasum 1-2' Abundant red-pink flowers in spring, chive-like foliage T

Allium misc. 12" 1.5" pale purple flowers, flat leaves in midsummer L

Amsonia (blue star) sun/part shade

Amsonia hubrechtii 4-5' Very fine textured foliage with light blue flowers. Great fall golden color. Easy to grow and long lived. Structural plant. T

Amsonia tabernaemontana 3-4' Willow-like leaves, golden fall color, light blue starry flowers May-June, easy to grow, long-lived. Structural plant. T, F, L

Anemone (Japanese windflower) part shade

Anemone robustissima 2-3' Abundant silvery pink flowers, attractive foliage. Late summer to fall. T

Aquilegia (columbine) sun/shade

Aquilegia General: There are many forms of this wonderful flower: some form a delicate star of outer petals surrounding an inner ring with yellow centers - some have long spurs that project out behind the blossoms - others are spurless with double blossoms

Aquilegia alpina 18-24" Tall blue species, native to Swiss alps, deep blue flower in spring F

Aquilegia biedermeier 20" Charming old fashioned cottage garden variety, covered with double mauve pink upward-facing blooms. Looks like granny's bonnet. T

Aquilegia biedermeier 20" Covered with white, pink or mauve blooms. P

Aquilegia canadensis 2-3' Native columbine, red/yellow flowers P

Aquilegia chrysantha 'Denver Gold' 30" Huge 3" yellow flowers with exceptionally long spurs that bloom heavily in spring and often rebloom if flowers stems are cut back. T

Aquilegia 'Nora Barlow' 32" Soft red petals tipped with white, held high above foliage O

Aquilegia 'Songbird Cardinal' 24-28" Award winning variety with bicolor red/white flowers	O
Aquilegia 'Winky Series' Blue and White 14-20" Plant near front of border, blue highlighted with white & blue spurs, bloom in April-May	T
Aquilegia misc. 'Anything Goes' 2' Graceful, pendulous flowers of mixed colors, compact mounding bluish green foliage, easy care, reseeds. A wealth of flowers in sun or shade	T,F

Aruncus dioicus 4' Indestructible native for part shade, fluffy plumes of creamy white flowers	F
Asarum (wild ginger) part shade/shade	
Asarum canadense 6-12" Native groundcover, heart shaped green leaves	P
Asarum europeum 6-12" Glossy green groundcover for shade	L
Asclepias (swamp milkweed, butterfly weed) sun/part shade	
Asclepias incarnata 3-4' Small, fragrant, pink to mauve umbels in July-Aug. Flowers are attractive to butterflies & larval stage of Monarchs. Erect, clump-forming, with branching stems. Attractive 3-4" seed pods which split open when ripe releasing silky-haired seeds carried by the wind.	T
Asclepias incarnata 'Cinderella' 3-5' Hassle-free, offering 3 months of vanilla-scented, rose-pink flowers in large, compact clusters from midsummer to early fall. Deadhead for rebloom. Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies & bees. Wonderful for cutting, long-lasting. Typical milkweed seed pods rupture	T
Aster (Michaelmas Daisies) sun/part shade	
Aster General: Asters are invaluable in the hardy border, adding superb color in the autumn. Very durable and long lived. Tolerates heavy, wet soils. Mounds of color beginning in September, in a full range of colors. Pinchd back early summer for best display.	T
Aster novae-angliae, misc. 3' Lavender, pink, purple	T, L
Aster novi-belgii 'Royal Opal' 12-15" Dwarf, purplish blue flowers w/yellow centers, fall	F
Aster novi-belgii 'Snow Cushion' 10-14" Dwarf, perfect little sparkling white mounds of color beginning in September.	T
Aster oblongifolius 'October Skies' 18" Compact plants covered with dark blue flowers in fall	O
Astilbe (false spiraea, plume flower) part shade/shade	
Astilbe chinensis v. pumila 10" This is a dwarf variety with red-green leaves. Striking plume-like flowers of reddish pink	T
Astilbe misc. 2' Attractive delicate fern-like foliage with showy frothy plumes midsummer in shades of pink, peach, white, rose, red. Lush deeply cut foliage is attractive for the entire season and is colored from green to bronze. Prefers rich moist soil. Deer resistant.	P, L

Astrantia major 'Margery Fish' 2-3' Also known as 'Shaggy'. Charming cottage garden plant, long lasting flowers. Starry white flowers with pale pink/green tips.	T

Baptisia australis 3'-5' Native, spikes of bluish purple lupine-like blooms in summer.	F
Baptisia sphaerocarpa 2'-3' Yellow wild indigo. Similar to above, with yellow flowers	F
Baptisia 'Purple Smoke' 3'-4' Violet blue lupine-like flower. Smokey purple stems, gray green unique foliage. Vigorous.	T, P
Brunnera (Siberian bugloss) part shade	
Brunnera macrophylla 18-24" Resembles a giant forget me not. Sky blue flowers. Limited	F
Campanula (bellflower) sun/part shade	
Campanula General: One of our favorites! Campanulas are marvelous. A large genus from low growing to tall stately specimens (white, pink, rose, blue, lavender). Long lived, easy care.	
Campanula glomerata 'Superba' (clustered bellflower) 1-2' Upward facing clusters of richly colored violet 'bells'. Blooms heavily in late spring through early summer.	F,L,O
Campanula glomerata 'Alba' (clustered bellflower) 12" Upward facing clusters, white flowers	L
Campanula lactiflora 'Dwarf Pink' (milky bellflower) 16" Heavy clusters of attractive soft pink flowers on shorter plants. A Fleuroselect winner that will bloom its first year.	T

	Campanula persicifolia 'Telham Beauty' (peach leaved bellflower) 2' Sky blue cup shaped bells on graceful spikes in early summer. Good cut flower. Will rebloom if spikes are cut.	T
	Campanula persicifolia (peach leaved bellflower) 2' White or purple spikes, easy, self seeds	F
	Campanula portenschlagiana (dalmation bellflower) 6-9" Light blue flowers late spring through summer. Rounded leaves are crinkled and irregularly toothed. Vigorous sprawling star covered beauty, perfect spilling over edges.	T
	Campanula rotundifolia 'Olympica' (bluebells of Scotland) 8-12" Fine textured foliage with small blue bells. Does well in shade blooming from June to August.	T
	Campanula takesimana 'Elizabeth' 8" Tubular pale pink to maroon flowers, summer - 2' flower stalks	O

	Centaurea dealbata 2' Pink flowers, long period of bloom	L

	Chelone lyonii 2-4' Snapdragon-like, two-lipped, clear pink flowers to 1" long from late summer into fall, resemble the heads of open-mouthed turtles. Coarsely-toothed, ovate to broad-lanceolate, dark green leaves. Best grown in moist, humusy soils	T, P

	Chrysanthemum koreana 'Sheffield' (aka Dendranthema rubellum) 30" Salmony pink yellowed eyed daisy flowers in abundance, very long flowering. A bright patch of fall color.	T

	Cimicifuga racemosa 5-6' Tall spikes of tiny white flowers, big leaves, dramatic shade perennial	F, P
Coreopsis (tickseed) sun/part shade		
	Coreopsis grandiflora misc. 2-3' Golden yellow, semi-double flowers from early summer into fall. Superb in the border. Provides a wealth of cut flowers. Deer resistant.	T

	Digitalis grandiflora 2'-3' Perennial yellow foxglove, creamy pale yellow flowers	F
Echinacea (coneflower) sun/part shade		
	<u>Echinacea General</u>: One of the best border plants. Flower petals radiate downward from a pronounced central seed head. Excellent cut flower, attractive to butterflies. Easy to grow. Flowers from July to frost.

	Eupatorium rugosum 'Chocolate' (white snakeroot) 3-5' Tall masses of chocolate-purple leaves with shiny deep purple stems. Huge heads of small white flowers 1' across in autumn. Likes moist shade.	T

	Euphorbia cyparissias 'Fens Ruby' Lime green flowers on maroon foliage	L

	Matteuccia struthiopteris 'Ostrich Fern' 3-6' Green fronds are shaped like ostrich plumes. Dramatic. Spreads. Needs moist soil.	T

	Filipendula palmata 4' Victorian looking foamy sprays of creamy pinkish white, late June. Attractive palmate foliage. Easy care.	T, P
Fragaria (ornamental strawberry) sun		
	Fragaria 'Pink Panda' 4-6" Strawberry type foliage with bright pink flowers, blooms late summer to fall.	O
Gaillardia (Indian blanket) sun		
	Gaillardia aristata 'Orange & Lemon' 12-15" Showy yellow/orange flowers in summer, long flowering. Loose poor well drained soil best.	T
Galium (sweet woodruff) part shade/shade		
	Galium odoratum 8" Delightful groundcover with starry white flowers.	P,O
Geranium (cranesbill) sun/part shade		
	Geranium General: Easy to grow, dense mound attractive foliage, masses of flowers. Cut back taller varieties after first bloom to encourage rebloom and compactness	
	Geranium maculatum 18" Pinkish lilac flowers in spring. Foliage scalloped green turning fawn and red in fall. Clump forming.	P
	Geranium sanguineum Low growing, 1" fuschia flowers much of season	L
	Geranium, misc. 15-18" Magenta or white flowers on mounding plants	F

GRASSES & GRASS-LIKE PLANTS		
	Note: Grasses make a marvelous addition to a perennial border and add much desired fall interest as well as structural form. Plumes or seed heads as well as cut grass can be used in fresh flower & dried arrangements, They are long-lived, sustainable, easy to grow. Grasses below are clumping unless otherwise noted.	
	Calamagrostis brachytricha 'Achy Breaky' 2-3' Purple tinted 'feathers' in late August	P

Carex misc. 2' sun/part shade Interesting vase like habit of flowing fine textured foliage that forms a large clump and is a great filler plant. Interesting seed heads.	T
Chasmanthum latifolium 'Northern Sea Oats' 3' part shade Intererenting flat oat-like tan seed fronds on arching panicles in fall, excellent winter interest and good dried. One of the best grasses!	T, F
Elymus arenarius 'Blue Lyme' (blue wild rye) 18-24" sun/part shade Showy wide metallic-blue glaucous foliage. Drought tolerant. Travels.	T, F
Festuca glauca (blue fescue) 8"	P
Miscanthus sinensis misc. (maiden grass) 5-6' sun/part shade Feathery plume above the plant. Billowy texture, different colorations. Spectacular fall & winter interest. Rustles in the wind.	T
Molinia arundinacea 'Skyracer' (moor grass) 4' sun/part shade Excellent ornamental grass with delicate 7-8' seed fronds above arching foliage. Moist soil preferred.	T
Panicum virgatum 'Dallas Blues' (switch grass) 4' sun/part shade Blue-green leaves, plum colored plumes in fall, good cut. Nice in perennial beds.	T
Panicum virgatum 'Heavy Metal' (switch grass) 4' sun Metallic blue leaves topped with clusters of pinkish flowers, turning maroon in the fall.	F
Pennisetum (fountain grass) 6'-7' sun Very tall grass, fuzzy flower plumes	F
Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hameln' (dwarf fountain grass) 18-30" sun/part shade Finely textured rich green foliage, arching coppery tan seed plumes showing into winter. A very popular grass - good in perennial border, mixed grass garden, or by itself.	T
Phalaris minor 'Lesser Canary Grass' (ribbon grass) 2' sun/part shade Green, white & pink variegated. Spreads but not the common invasive variety.	T

Note: Herbs from 42 Bond Street garden are dug to order. Take a walk through the herb garden, pinch & sniff the wonderful fragrances. Most herbs thrive in full sun and tolerate poor dry soil. Mints and Sweet Woodruff will grow in partial shade.	
Chives 10-15" sun Several varieties including garden, garlic and broad leaf (<i>dug to order</i>)	T
Marjoram misc. (oregano) 12-18" sun Several varieties: try mild for fresh use & strong for drying. (<i>dug to order</i>)	T
Melissa officinalis (lemon balm) 15-20" sun/part shade Cullinary use as herb or tea, fresh or dried. Pinch to smell strong fragrance. (<i>dug to order</i>)	T
Melissa officinalis 'Lime' (lime balm) 15-20" sun/part shade Unusual! Brilliant lime-gold variegation for use in borders or cullinary use fresh in beverages or dried for tea. Heady lime fragrance. (<i>dug to order</i>)	T
Mentha (mint) misc. 1-3' sun/part shade Choose from several varieties including clumping mountain mint. Best controlled by planting in an open ended, sunken bucket. Wonderful fresh in iced drinks & salads. Dry for teas.	T
Nepeta cataria 'Citriodora' 2' sun Lemon scented catmint. Variety of the cat friendly herb, but with strongly lemon scented foliage	F
Rocamboles 20" sun Garlic-like, milder substitute. Use green stalks or bulbous root. (<i>dug to order</i>)	T
Thymus misc. (thyme) 2-6" sun A variety of thymes that need to be sniffed to be appreciated. (<i>dug to order</i>)	T

Helianthus 'Lemon Queen' 5'-6' Tall perennial sunflower, numerous 2" yellow flowers late summer	F
Helleborus (lenten rose, hellebore) part shade/shade	
Helleborus General: One of our favorites! Woodland plants with clumps of glossy leaves and clusters of cup shaped flowers. Earliest perennial to bloom in late winter. Float flowers in bowl of water. Good beneath deciduous trees. Deer resistant, slug proof, evergreen.	
Helleborus argutifolius 2' Awesome clusters of large heads of uniform apple green flowers that last in water. Stout stems and sharply spined leaves mark it apart from all other hellebores.	T
Helleborus foetidus 2-4' Truly blooms in late winter with awesome clusters of green bells, deeply palmate leaves.	T

Helleborus orientalis 'Lady Metallic Blue' 18-24" A pewter sheen to these large bowl-shaped flowers of rich purplish-blue. Beautiful and easy to grow.	T
Helleborus orientalis 'Sunshine Selections' 2-4' Long-lasting 2-3" nodding cup shaped flowers in clusters, unique colors ranging from white to pink to mauve to maroon, patterns ranging from speckled to streaked to shaded.	T

Heuchera 'Citronelle' 12" Chartreuse yellow leaves, small white flowers, no sun	K
