	<b>Achillea (yarrow) sun / well drained soil</b>	
K	<b>Achillea 'Debutante' 18-24"</b> 6" flowerheads sturdy stems, mix of ivory, gold, red, orange.	
T	<b>Achillea ptarmica 'Ballerina' (angel's breath) 12"</b> Sprays of pure white flowers in late spring that resemble baby's breath. Carefree. Spreads.	N
	<b>Actaea (bugbane / baneberry) sun/pt.shade (reclassified from Cimicifuga)</b>	
L	<b>Actaea alba (doll's eyes) 2'</b> Clump forming with white flowers on 3' stalks that turn into white berries with black eye-like dots in fall.	
P F L	<b>(Cimicifuga) racemosa 5-6'</b> Native, slender spikes of white flowers in summer. Striking.	
P L	<b>(Cimicifuga) simplex 'Brunette' 6'</b> Fall blooming, white flowers, very fragrant, dark stems/leaves. Takes shade.	
	<b>Agastache (hyssop) sun</b>	
F	<b>Agastache foeniculum 2-3' sun</b> Violet blue spikes of flowers, minty foliage, attracts butterflies.	
	<b>Alchemilla (lady's mantle) sun/pt.shade</b>	
T P L	<b>Alchemilla mollis 10-16"</b> Handsome edger. Sprays of chartreuse flowers in July, splendid fan shaped pleated foliage that collect dew drops as sparkling jewels, good cut flowers.	
	<b>Allium (ornamental onion) sun / well drained soil</b>	
	<b>Allium General:</b> Drought tolerant. Very easy to grow, carefree, needs a dry location. Showy in mass. Flowers can be dried by standing upright in a container without water. Blossoms tower above foliage. Deer proof.	
T	<b>Allium hollandicum 'Purple Sensation' 2'</b> Large purple sphere blossoms on 3' stems, let self seed after 1st year, summer dormant so inter-plant with perennials.	
T L	<b>Allium senescens 1'</b> Bright green flat foliage. 3" lavender-pink umbels on 20" stems in July-Aug. Drought tolerant.	
L	<b>Allium misc. 12"</b> Pale 1.5" purple flowers in midsummer	
	<b>Amsonia (blue star) sun/pt.shade</b>	
T F L	<b>Amsonia tabernaemontana 3-4'</b> Willow-like leaves, golden fall color, light blue starry flowers May-June, easy to grow, long-lived. Structural plant.	
	<b>Anemone (Japanese windflower) pt.shade</b>	
T	<b>Anemone hupehensis 'September Charm' 2-3'</b> Abundant silvery pink flowers late summer-fall. Attractive foliage.	
P	<b>Anemone japonica 'Alice' 32"</b> Choice pink variety with extra large double flowers. Outstanding in late summer to fall.	N
O L	<b>Anemone tomentosa 'Robustissima' 3'</b> Pale pink flowers on extremely hardy plants.	
T	<b>Anemone 'Whirlwind' 3'</b> Large semi-double white petals, golden center. Late summer to fall.	

	<b>Aquilegia (columbine) sun/shade</b>	
	<b><u>Aquilegia General:</u></b> There are many forms of this wonderful flower: some form a delicate star of outer petals surrounding an inner ring with yellow centers - some have long spurs that project out behind the blossoms - others are spurless with double blossoms. All are graceful, with blue-green foliage. Aquilegia is easy to grow in loose, average to rich, well-drained soil. Self sow without being annoying.	
L	<b>Aquilegia vulgaris 'Black Barlow' 32"</b> Eye catching near black double, spurless flowers	
T	<b>Aquilegia vulgaris 'Clementine Red' 18"</b> Large fuchsia red spurless flowers resembling double Clematis. Upright habit, larger leafed foliage that is attractive all season. Cut flowers are long lasting. Easy to grow.	N
L	<b>Aquilegia vulgaris 'Nora Barlow' 32"</b> Soft rosy petals tipped with white, held high above foliage	
T	<b>Aquilegia misc. 'Anything Goes' 2"</b> Graceful, pendulous flowers of mixed colors, compact mounding bluish green foliage, easy care, reseeds. A wealth of flowers in sun or shade.	
L	<b>Aquilegia misc.</b> Tall dark purple long blooming flowers.	
	<b>Arisaema (Jack in the Pulpit) pt.shade/shade</b>	
T	<b>Arisaema triphyllum 18-24"</b> Hooded bloom, striped in green, brown and white; scarlet-orange fruit in fall.	L
	<b>Armeria (seathrift) sun</b>	
K	<b>Armeria 'Joystick Red' 16"</b> Red globe shaped flowers on strong stems.	N
	<b>Aruncus (goatsbeard) pt.shade/shade</b>	
L	<b>Aruncus aethusifolius 18" (dwarf)</b> Fern like leaves, astilbe-like but more compact, white flowers in summer.	
F O L	<b>Aruncus dioicus 2'</b> Native perennial with plumes of fluffy white flowers to 6', resembles a giant astilbe with fern-like foliage. Tough as nails.	
	<b>Asarum (ginger) (groundcover) pt.shade/shade</b>	
T P L	<b>Asarum europaeum 3"</b> Glossy green kidney-shaped foliage; elegant groundcover for shade. Easy, carefree.	
	<b>Asclepias (swamp milkweed / butterfly weed) sun/pt.shade</b>	
F	<b>Asclepias tuberosa 'Best Gold' 2'</b> Bright gold variety of butterfly weed; monarch host plant.	N
	<b>Aster (Michaelmas daisies) sun/pt.shade</b>	
	<b><u>Aster General:</u></b> Asters are invaluable in the hardy border, adding superb color in the autumn. Very durable and long lived. Even heavy, wet soils will suit them. Mounds of color beginning in September, in a full range of colors. Pinch back before July for best display.	
L	<b>Aster novae-angliae 'Alma Potschke' 4-5'</b> Bright pink daisy-like flowers, cut back to 12" early July for fuller bloom.	
L	<b>Aster novae-angliae 'Purple Dome' 20"</b> Compact and free flowering. A stunning, deep purple. Disease resistant.	
F	<b>Aster novi-belgii 'Royal Opal' 12-15"</b> Compact, purplish blue flowers w/yellow centers, fall.	
L	<b>Aster novi-belgii cv. 15-24"</b> Daisy-like flowers, shades of purple, blue and pink in fall.	
O	<b>Aster oblongifolius 'October Skies' 18"</b> Compact plants covered. Glows with dark blue flowers in fall after most flowers are gone.	
	<b>Astilbe (false spiraea / plume flower) pt.shade/shade</b>	
	<b><u>Astilbe General:</u></b> Attractive delicate fern-like foliage with showy frothy plumes midsummer in shades of pink, peach, white, rose, red. Lush deeply cut foliage is attractive for the entire season and is colored from green to bronze. Prefers rich moist soil. Can take sun if well watered. Deer resistant.	
L	<b>Astilbe arendsii 'Bridal Veil' 2-3'</b> Long-lasting white plumes in summer over fern-like foliage.	
L	<b>Astilbe chinensis v. pumila 10"</b> This is a dwarf variety with red-green leaves. Great used as groundcover. Striking plume-like flowers of reddish pink	
T O L	<b>Astilbe hybrids misc.</b> Long lasting feathery plumes in summer, fern like foliage. Bright pink, pale pink, or white	
	<b>Astrantia (masterwort) pt.shade</b>	
T L	<b>Astrantia major 18"</b> Pink tinged 1" white flowers, midsummer long bloomer.	

	<b>Baptisia (false indigo) sun/pt.shade</b>		
T P L		<b>Baptisia australis 3-4'</b> <u>2010 PPA Plant of the Year</u> Native, 12" spikes of blue lupine-like blooms, long lived & carefree. Bushy clump of blue-green foliage, good cut foliage & flowers, attractive seed pods for crafting.	N
	<b>Belamcanda (blackberry lily) sun</b>		
F		<b>Belamcanda 2'-3'</b> Speckled orange flowers, tall stems, iris like foliage, summer bloom.	N
	<b>Boltonia (false aster) sun</b>		
T		<b>Boltonia asteroides Pink 3'</b> Late summer bloom, airy clump, excellent cut flower.	
	<b>Brunnera (Siberian bugloss) pt.shade</b>		
P F		<b>Brunnera macrophylla 12-18"</b> Lovely shade perennial for moist soil, sky blue flowers in April/May. Resembles a giant forget me not! Resents dry soil.	
T P		<b>Brunnera macrophylla 'Dawson's White' 15-18"</b> Grown for its foliage. Heart-shaped, dark green leaves w/wide irregular cream to white margins. Boquets of small blue forget-me-not flowers late spring.	N
	<b>Campanula (bellflower) sun/pt.shade</b>		
		<b><u>Campaula General:</u></b> One of our favorites! Campanulas are marvelous. A large genus from low growing to tall stately specimens (white, pink, rose, blue, lavender flowers). Long lived, easy care.	
T		<b>Campanula 'Birch Hybrid' 4'6"</b> Profusion of lavender-blue, 1 inch long, fluted bell-shaped flowers late spring to late summer if deadheaded. Forms spreading mats to make good groundcover. Use in containers, rock gardens, on slopes, or in crevices.	N
L		<b>Campanula glomerata 'Alba' 12"</b> Clusters of white flowers, long bloom in summer.	
O L		<b>Campanula glomerata 'Superba' 1-2'</b> Upward facing clusters of richly colored violet 'bells'. Blooms heavily in late spring through early summer.	
T F L		<b>Campanula persicifolia misc. 8" (2-3' in bloom)</b> Sky blue or white cup shaped bells on graceful spikes in early summer. Good cut flower. Will rebloom if spikes are cut.	
T		<b>Campanula punctata 'Wedding Bells' 30"</b> Upright stems with huge drooping white double bells, flushed with soft pink. Vigorous!	
	<b>Centaurea (perennial bachelor button) sun/pt.shade</b>		
L		<b>Centaurea dealbata 2'</b> Dark pink 1-2" flowers, often needs staking, reblooms. Fern-like foliage.	
L		<b>Centaurea montana 2'</b> Violet-blue showy fringed flowers, lance-like silvery-green foliage, cut back after flowering for rebloom.	
	<b>Centranthus (Jupiter's Beard) sun</b>		
O		<b>Centranthus ruber 2'-3'</b> Rose red flowers rising on dark stems all summer.	
	<b>Chrysanthemum (garden mums) sun/pt.shade</b>		
T		<b>Chrysanthemum koreana 'Sheffield' (aka Dendranthema rubellum) 30"</b> Salmony pink yellowed eyed daisy flowers in abundance, very long flowering. A mound of color.	
P		<b>Chrysanthemum misc. 2'</b> Small yellow flowers cover plant in late summer/early fall for many weeks. Likes full sun. Cut back stems by July 1 to control height & encourage bushy growth.	
O		<b>Chrysanthemum misc. 2'</b> Rust colored, blooms mid summer to early fall.	
	<b>Cimicifuga - Reclassified to Actaea</b>		
	<b>Coreopsis (tickseed) sun/pt.shade</b>		
T		<b>Coreopsis grandiflora 'Early Sunrise' 3'</b> Golden yellow, semi-double flowers from early summer into fall. Superb in the border. Provides a wealth of cut flowers. Deer resistant.	
T		<b>COREOPSIS tripteris 6'</b> Statuesque with 2" butter yellow daisies in July and September. Birds love the seeds. Deer resistant.	
F L		<b>Coreopsis verticillata 'Zagreb' 12-18"</b> Golden yellow flowers all summer atop threadlike foliage. Spreads through underground runners. Long blooming.	
L		<b>Coreopsis verticillata 'Rosea' 12-18"</b> Rosy pink 1" flowers all summer atop threadlike foliage. Long blooming.	
	<b>Corydalis (cordyalis) sun/shade</b>		
T F		<b>Corydalis lutea 8-12"</b> Delicate leafy foliage, free flowering from May to September, cheery yellow flowers. Prefers rich, moist soils that never dry out in summer but not wet in winter.	

	<b>Cryptotaenia (Japanese parsley) sun/pt.shade</b>	
F	<b>Cryptotaenia japonica atropurpurea 26"</b> Attractive chocolate colored maple-like foliage, tiny pale pink flowers, nice color contrast in borders.	
	<b>Delosperma (ice plant) sun</b>	
A	<b>Delosperma 'John Proffitt' 4"</b> Purple flowers June-Sept.	N
K	<b>Delosperma 'Starburst' 3-6"</b> Bright lavender/pink flowers with white centers, succulent foliage.	N
K	<b>Delosperma misc. 4-6"</b> Bright lavender/pink flowers white centers May-June, succulent foliage.	N
	<b>Dianthus (maiden pinks) sun / well drained soil</b>	
T	<b>Dianthus 'Agatha' 6-10"</b> Semi-double pink with a darker eye. Very durable & quite fragrant. Spreading habit, extra longevity. Deadhead to prolong bloom. Needs good drainage. Excellent as edging and in rock gardens & walls.	N
T	<b>Dianthus misc 6"</b> Clove scented single pink. Needs good drainage. Excellent as edging and in rock gardens & walls.	
	<b>Dicentra (bleeding heart) pt.shade/shade</b>	
P	<b>Dicentra culcullaria (Dutchman's Breeches) 12"</b> Pink or white heart-shaped flowers, ever blooming. Grayish-green fern-like foliage.	
L	<b>Dicentra eximia (fringed bleeding heart) 15"</b> Ferny, clumping grayish-green foliage. Pink nodding heart-shaped flowers spring through summer.	
P	<b>Dicentra spectabilis misc. 2-3"</b> Sprays of pendant, heart-shaped flowers above fern-like foliage in spring. Either showy deep rose or white. Summer dormant.	
	<b>Digitalis (foxglove) sun/pt.shade</b>	
F	<b>Digitalis grandiflora (perennial) 3'</b> Pale yellow flowers, shorter than biennial varieties.	
T	<b>Digitalis purpurea (biennial) 4'</b> Pastel shades of creamy yellow, pinks, & roses. Tall flower spikes with charming tubular flowers add height & vertical accent. Attract hummingbirds. Leave some stalks to re-seed as this is a true biennial.	N
	<b>Doronicum (leopard's bane) sun/pt.shade</b>	
F	<b>Doronicum 12-18"</b> Yellow flowers, April to May.	
	<b>Echinacea (coneflower) sun/pt.shade</b>	
	<b><u>Echinacea General:</u></b> One of the best border plants. Flower petals radiate downward from a pronounced central seed head. Excellent cut flower, attractive to butterflies. Easy to grow. Flowers from July to frost.	
K	<b>Echinacea 'Magnus' 3-4'</b> Extra large hot pink blooms June - September.	
T P F L	<b>Echinacea purpurea 3'</b> Big daisy-like lavender pink blooms on stately plants. Showy!	
F	<b>Echinacea purpurea, white form 2-3'</b> White flowered variety.	
K	<b>Echinacea 'White Swan' 2-3'</b> Creamy white flowers with golden cones.	
	<b>Echinops (globe thistle) sun</b>	
F	<b>Echinops ritro 3'</b> Steely blue spiky globe shaped flowers on sturdy stems in summer. Drought tolerant.	
	<b>Epimedium (barrenwort / bishop's hat) pt.shade/shade</b>	
T L	<b>Epimedium rubrum 8-12"</b> Bright crimson and cream white flowers, spring bloom. Pointed, heart-shaped leaflets on wiry stems, new growth has reddish tinge, reddish fall color.	
P	<b>Epimedium versicolor 'Sulfureum' 10-15"</b> Delicate sprays of yellow spring flowers. Lush, heart shaped foliage, semi-evergreen groundcover, drought tolerant when established.	
	<b>Euphorbia (spurge) sun/pt.shade</b>	
L	<b>Euphorbia cyparissias 'Fens Ruby' 6"</b> Late spring, chartreuse bracts, yellow flowers, blue green foliage. Spreads especially in sun - better behaved in shade.	
T L	<b>Euphorbia dulcis 'Chameleon' 12-18"</b> Yellow flowers with the outer bracts turning chartreuse. Luscious purple-maroon foliage - the more sun the deeper the foliage. Self seeds.	
P	<b>Euphorbia x martinii 'Tiny Tim' 12"</b> Compact dome-shaped mound of light green foliage blooms continuously thru entire season with bright red nugget centered chartreuse flowers. For front of the border or a mixed container. Drought tolerate, deer resistant.	N

T		<b>Euphorbia myrsinites (donkey tail) 6-9"</b> Lime yellow bracts, succulent blue-green leaves spiral around trailing stems, excellent for rock garden, groundcover or stone wall.	
L		<b>Euphorbia polychroma 14"</b> Clumping plant, oval leaves, bright yellow bracts, fall color.	
		<b>FERNS <i>pt.shade/shade</i></b>	
T		<b>Adiantum pedatum 'Maidenhair' 30"</b> Hardy and fast growing fern with delicate appearance. Rich green fronds on black stems. Needs good air circulation.	
P		<b>Asparagus officinalis var. pseudoscaber (hardy asparagus fern) 4'</b> A striking accent & great textural element with delicate lacy green clouds of see-through foliage. 2' wide mound of foliage lasts into early fall, when it changes to yellow with a crop of red berries. (Note: this rarely gets divided)	
T		<b>Athyrium niponicum 'Pictum' (Japanese painted fern) 16"</b> <i>2004 Perennial Plant of the Year!</i> A showy combination of colorful fronds of grey-green blended with wine red. Lacy leaves are wide and taper to a delicate point. Deer resistant.	
L		<b>Dryopteris misc. 2'</b> Hardy woodland fern that doesn't mind some afternoon sun. Spreads on underground runners.	
A		<b>Dryopteris erythrosora (autumn fern) 18"</b> Colorfull groundcover with pink fiddleheads that turn coppery orange as they unfurl giving tapestry effect.	
L		<b>Dryopteris filix-mas (male fern) 3'</b> Upright habit, lance-shaped 2 pinnate fronds. Moist, fertile, acidic soil. A grand statement in the woodland garden.	
T		<b>Matteuccia struthiopteris 'Ostrich Fern' 3-6'</b> Green fronds are shaped like ostrich plumes. Dramatic. Spreads. Needs moist soil.	
		<b>Filipendula (meadowsweet) <i>sun/shade</i></b>	
T		<b>Filipendula hexapetala 'Flore Plena' 2-3'</b> Elegantly divided deep green leaves and creamy-white double flowers on graceful feathery plumes. Like an Astilbe on steroids - consistent performer, carefree, deer resistant.	
L		<b>Filipendula hexapetala misc. 2'</b> Native perennial bears heads of fluffy creamy white flowers above fern like foliage.	
O L		<b>Filipendula 'Kahome' 1'</b> Sprays of rosy flowers over green rosettes, July-August.	
L		<b>Filipendula palmata 'Nana' 16"</b> Mounding habit. Feathery plumes of rosy-pink flowers.	
T		<b>Filipendula palmata misc. 4'</b> Victorian looking foamy sprays of creamy pinkish white, late June. Attractive palmate foliage. Easy care.	
L		<b>Filipendula ulmaria 'Variagata' 2'</b> Creamy white flowers over variagated yellow & green leaves	
		<b>Fragaria (ornamental strawberry) <i>sun</i></b>	
T O		<b>Fragaria 'Pink Panda' 4- 6"</b> Strawberry type foliage with bright pink flowers, blooms late summer to fall.	
L		<b>Fragaria 'Lipstick' 4- 6"</b> Glossy 'running' strawberry type foliage with bright rosy flowers, blooms late summer to fall. Carefree.	
		<b>Galium</b>	
T		<b>Galium mollugo 'Victor Jones' (false baby's breath) 4' <i>sun</i></b> Tiny white flowers in summer, forming a cloud to weave through heavier plants. Whorled thread-like leaves.	N
T O		<b>Galium odoratum (sweet woodruff) 6" <i>pt.shade/shade</i></b> Ground cover for partially shaded, moist areas. Tiny, white, star-shaped flowers appear in late spring above a carpet of green foliage. Good to hide dying bulb foliage. Fragrant leaves - used dried for May wine.	
		<b>Gaura (wand flower) <i>sun</i></b>	
T L		<b>Gaura lindheimeri 'Whirling Butterflies' 3-4'</b> Vase shaped plant that never stops blooming through October, white flowers dance in a breeze on arching stems, nice in center of border, low basal foliage, hardier than pink variety.	
		<b>Geranium (cranesbill) <i>sun/pt.shade</i></b>	
		<b><u>Geranium General:</u></b> Easy to grow, dense mound attractive foliage, masses of flowers. Cut back taller varieties after first bloom to encourage rebloom and compactness.	
L		<b>Geranium cantabrigiense 'Karmina' 6"-10"</b> Spreading plant with massed pink flowers	
L T		<b>Geranium macrorrhizum 15"</b> Dark pink 1" flowers held above foliage. Will spread to 2' wide over time. Good rebloomer.	

T O	<b>Geranium macrorrhizum 'Ingwersen's Variety' 12-18"</b> A great groundcover geranium. Light pink flowers with darker sepals and stems are held high above wonderfully fragrant foliage. Tolerates bright shade and drier soils.	
T F	<b>Geranium maculatum 18"</b> Pinkish lilac flowers in spring. Scalloped green foilage. Clump forming.	
L	<b>Geranium sanguineum 8-12"</b> Carmine-rose 1" flowers , June bloom with excellent rebloom throughout the summer on low plant. Hardy.	
L	<b>Geranium, misc. 12-18"</b> Dark pink, magenta or carmine rose flowers	
<b>GRASSES &amp; GRASS-LIKE PLANTS</b>		
	<b>Note:</b> Grasses make a marvelous addition to a perennial border and add much desired fall interest as well as structural form. Plumes or seed heads as well as grass blades can be used in fresh flower & dried arrangements, They are long-lived, sustainable, easy to grow. Grasses below are clumping unless otherwise noted.	
T P F	<b>Chasmanthum latifolium 'Northern Sea Oats' 3' pt.shade</b> Interesting flat oat-like tan seed fronds on arching panicles in fall, excellent winter interest and good dried. One of the best grasses!	
T	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Cosmopolitan' (maiden grass) 4' sun</b> Robust creamy white & green variegated leaves. Non-floppy habit. Billowy texture, silky tassels dry easily, great winter interest. Good for hot dry spots.	N
T	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Sarabande' (maiden grass) 4-5' sun</b> Grows in an upright clump & features narrow, arching, dark green leaves with silvery margins. Sprays of blush-hued flower plumes emerge straight as arrows, then open looking freshly crimped and fade to silver, persist well into winter.	N
T	<b>Miscanthus sinensis misc. (maiden grass) 4-6' sun/pt.shade</b> Feathery plume above the plant. Billowy texture, different heights and colorations. Fall & winter interest. Add vertical structure to garden. Carefree.	
T	<b>Panicum virgatum 'Dallas Blues' (blue switch grass) 5' sun</b> Airy, mauve flower heads with a purple cast. Makes a peaceful swishing sound when blowing in the wind. Effective as a specimen, in masses, for screening, alongside ponds or streams.	N
T	<b>Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Little Bunny' (miniature fountain grass) 6"-12" sun</b> Truly miniature w/cream-colored, tufted seed heads that look like a bunch of little bunnies' tails dancing. Suited to sunny rock gardens.	N
T	<b>Sesleria heufleriana (blue-green moor grass ) 12-16" sun/pt.shade</b> Dense, vigorous, mound-forming evergreen. Leaves are flat and linear, bright green on top, grayish green beneath. Panicles of white spikelets, maturing to purple, late spring to late summer.	N
F	<b>Sisyrinchium angustifolium (blue eyed grass) 16" sun</b> Not a true grass but a primitive iris. Yellow-centered bright blue almost daisy-like flowers May through July.	
<b>Helianthus (perennial sunflower) sun</b>		
P F	<b>Helianthus 'Lemon Queen' 6-7'</b> Very large with loads of yellow sunflower type flowers in late summer/fall. Not for small spaces!	
<b>Heliopsis (false sunflower) sun/pt.shade</b>
